Wind4All Communities Inc. to follow Wind4All Inc. success with a new CEDIF investment opportunity!

Wind4All Communities, the second in the Wind4All family of companies, launched their CEDIF Offering on December 18 2012, which means there is new opportunity to invest in late stage wind farm developments. Having been awarded COMFIT approval for two new wind farm projects, Wind4All Communities presents another chance for Nova Scotians to invest directly in green, renewable energy. Wind4All Communities has been created and sponsored by Natural Forces Wind Inc. (Natural forces).

Through this new CEDIF offering, Wind4All Communities will seek to raise up to \$5.5 million, the proceeds of which will be used to invest in two wind energy projects in the province. The CEDIF investor returns consist not only of dividends paid out by the wind farms but also the non-refundable equity tax credits, which amount to 65% of the initial investment, assuming a 15-year hold period¹.

Earlier this year Wind4All Inc. and Assante Capital Management Ltd (Assante) worked together to attract over 150 investors and raised almost \$2.4 million dollars, the proceeds of which have since been used to construct the Fairmont Wind Farm. This CEDIF Offering has since become the most successful renewable energy CEDIF offering to date. Over the next 20 years, it is anticipated that the Fairmont Wind Farm will produce enough electricity to power the homes of approximately 1,200 Nova Scotian families and, at the same time, offset roughly 10,000 tonnes of carbon dioxide annually.

Austen Hughes, President of Wind4All Communities says: "Our strategy for 2013 and our Wind4All Communities CEDIF offering is simple: Partner with a wind developer with a proven track record, engage a company capable of raising the required equity capital, and present a CEDIF Offering with a quantifiable rate of return. I believe Natural Forces, Assante and Wind4All Communities does this".

It is time to be a part of Nova Scotia's Energy evolution. Developing this new direction for energy supply in Nova Scotia requires leadership, commitment and passion. This is an opportunity to be actively involved in breaking our reliance on fossil fuels and opening the gate for profitable, community renewable energy".
