Wind4All Inc. Pays Investors First Dividend

Wind4All Inc. (“Wind4All”) has declared a dividend, the company’s first, in the amount of \$0.0185 per share, equating to a total shareholder distribution of \$43,503 for 2,351,500 shares. The dividend will be paid to its shareholders of record as of April 9th 2013 and was payable on April 12, 2013.

Last year, Wind4All invested in the Fairmont Wind Farm, a 4.6 MW wind farm located 6km north of Antigonish, consisting of two Enercon E82 2.3 MW wind turbines. Wind4All holds a 35% economic interest in the wind farm.

Construction of the Fairmont Wind Farm was completed on schedule in the fall of 2012 and the project immediately started delivering power to the grid. It is anticipated that the project will serve the electricity needs of 1,500 Nova Scotian families over the next 20 years.

A number of Antigonish and Pictou County businesses were involved in the construction of the Fairmont Wind Farm, and over 3 million dollars was spent both locally, and throughout the province of Nova Scotia, during the development and construction of the project.

With Assante Capital Management Ltd. acting as the exclusive selling agents under the CEDIF offering, over 150 Nova Scotians invested in the construction of the project through their investment in Wind4All. In total, the Wind4All CEDIF offering raised \$2,350,900, which successfully closed on February 29, 2012.

The project was developed by Natural Forces Wind Inc. (“Natural Forces”), a Maritimes company based in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Natural Forces personnel have over 30 years of combined experience in developing, constructing, and operating wind energy projects around the world.
