Natural Forces Launches Fifth and Final Wind Energy CEDIF in Nova Scotia.

Natural Forces Wind Inc. (Natural Forces) launched their fifth and likely final Community Economic Development Investment Fund (CEDIF) Offering in Nova Scotia today. It's called Wind4All Communities III Inc., and as with previous CEDIFs in the Wind4All "family", it intends to invest in Nova Scotian wind farms.

The CEDIF Offering aims to raise \$3 million by February 29, 2016 to fund the development and construction of two COMFIT-approved wind farms. Together, these two wind farms will generate enough renewable electricity to meet the needs of 1,600 Canadian homes:

- The single-turbine 1.6 MW Pictou Landing Wind Farm is located in Pictou County, approximately 20 kilometers east of New Glasgow.
- The two-turbine 6 MW Amherst Wind Farm is located in Cumberland County, approximately 6 kilometers east of the town of Amherst.

"CEDIFs are a local investment tool." says Austen Hughes, President of Wind4All Communities III Inc. "They allow regular people to help build Nova Scotia's renewable energy future while supporting local businesses. CEDIFs such as ours allow investors to avail of up to 65% of Non-refundable Provincial Equity Tax Credits¹, and many people don't realize they can even use their existing RRSP funds." All Nova Scotian residents over the age of 19 are eligible to buy shares in Wind4All Communities III Inc.

Under the CEDIF offering, Assante Financial Management Ltd. and Assante Capital Management Ltd. will be acting as the exclusive Selling Agents. Wind4All Communities III Inc. will aim sell a minimum of 1,750,000 shares and a maximum of 3,000,000 shares. Each share costs \$1.00. The minimum someone can invest is \$500, with the maximum investment being \$30,000.

The Sponsor under this CEDIF Offering is Natural Forces, a subsidiary of Natural Forces Technologies Inc., a Maritime-owned renewable energy company established in 2001 and based in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Since 2012 Natural Forces has established four similar CEDIFs - all were successfully funded and the wind farms they invested in are now operational. Notably, Natural Forces' first Wind4All (Wind4All Inc.) was established in 2012 and since that time, it has paid \$450,313 in dividends to its CEDIF shareholders.
